PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

As a representative of the town of Longmeadow, your child's team, the coaches and yourself, there are expectations of conduct and sportsmanship. Parents are expected to uphold the philosophies of fair play, sportsmanship, and respect for all players, opponents, coaches and referees. The essential elements of our code of conduct listed below must be adhered to at all times.

_____ I understand and will respect that the games are for youth- not adults.

_____ I believe in the value of good sportsmanship and fair play.

_____ I will always demonstrate positive behavior and respect towards my child's teammates, opponents, coaches, other parents, and spectators at games and at practice.

_____ I understand the commitment my child has made, and I have made, and will make every effort for my child to attend every game and practice that he/she can, and I will notify coach if they cannot.

_____ I understand that my child's commitment to Longmeadow Travel Soccer must take precedence over other extracurricular activities. By signing this, I commit to our attendance at all scheduled practices and games. I understand that by earning a spot on Travel Soccer, another child, who may have been willing and able to participate in 100% of the team's activities, did not make the team. Therefore, if we have scheduled activities that may conflict with this commitment, I will discuss them with LSA prior to committing to a travel team.

_____ I understand coaches are volunteers, and I will support coaches and officials working with my child in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.

_____ I pledge to approach the soccer experience with a positive attitude. I will abide by the PVJSL code of conduct and bylaws.
